

## Yellowstone Year Round Safaris

### Lake Yellowstone & Grand Canyon Snowmobile Safari

The Itinerary is designed to take advantage of the best opportunities in Yellowstone Park, but may be adjusted to adapt to weather conditions, animal movements, holidays, and road construction.

This Safari is for those that wish to explore a region of Yellowstone few visitors get to experience. This Itinerary has something for everyone, from thermals and wildlife to spectacular winter landscapes.

- Day 1            Welcome and Orientation  
Check into Best Western by Mammoth and Dinner on own.
- 7am.            Orientation in Best Western Conference room around the corner from  
The Lobby.  
Introduction to Yellowstone, program overview, clothing, equipment  
review, safety review and question and answer session.
- Grand Canyon Snowmobile tour
- 7:30 a.m.      Meet in the Hotel Lobby with gear for the day (pack, water, and  
appropriate clothing), ready to load. The shuttle bus. Travel 5 miles to  
Mammoth Hot Springs where you will board snowmobiles.  
Depart for Grand Canyon area via snowmobile with interpretive stops  
along the way.  
Stops at the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone with interpretive stops at  
the Upper Falls and Lower Falls, Both encased in ice and snow.  
Following the Yellowstone River into the Hayden Valley we will be  
watching for trumpeter swans and otters alongside the frozen  
shoreline.  
Traveling on exploring the unusual thermals of the Mud Volcano and  
Dragon's mouth spring.  
Stopping for lunch at Lake Yellowstone alongside the shores of this  
vast frozen body of water.  
On the trip back you will have the opportunity to view some of the  
Yellowstone's Diverse and abundant wildlife; bison, elk, coyotes,  
wolves and a variety of bird species, from Canadian Geese to Bald  
Eagles.
- 5:30            Return to the Best Western by Mammoth  
Check in any equipment used.
